The 39th Annual Bill Robinson Masters 10K was held on April 27 with 55 finishers, down from 63 last year. Aaron Knobloch, Margaret McKeown won. Next year is the 40th running. The Board discussed consideration of rescheduling to avoid the James Joyce Masters Run but it was acknowledged that the spring race calendar is already very busy. The Mother's Day 5k is Sunday, with 59 pre-registered. The Workforce Team Challenge is one week from tomorrow. The 10K max registration was reached and race registration is closed. Sunday, June 9th is the Distinguished Service Run. Jon will email all past winners to invite them to attend that day. June 10 and 11 is the Just Run Track Meet in Guilderland. Saturday, June 15 is the ValleyCats 5K. Colonie Track kicks off the next week. MHM/Half continues registration. Stockade-athon race opens in June. The MHM/HM has 800 registered in the half and 500 in the full. Maureen is deploying various marketing techniques to boost registration.
